DOC CAN DANCE set all the pace to the stretch, responded when roused in upper stretch and held gamely. SILVER TERRACE prompted the winner throughout, came two wide to the stretch then finished willingly but could not get by. TRUENO had no speed, settled to the half, bid three wide on the second turn, shifted out for room once in the stretch then was outkicked to mid stretch but kept to task and was up for the show. COAST GUARD RESCUE was four wide while stalking to the backstretch, settled to the second turn then tried to rally three deep but came up empty in the drive. TRIBAL SKY was allowed to settle early, raced mid pack to the second turn then was three wide, got outkicked to the stretch and did not threaten. JEHOVAH JIREH chased the leaders to the second turn then gave way after six furlongs. MINISTER D'ORO had no speed, saved ground to the second turn, made a brief bid to the stretch but tired in the lane.
