**Footnotes**

SKY FOX was outsprinted to the turn, came four wide to the stretch, rallied when set down and was along in time. KEVINATOR stalked the pace to the turn, also raced four deep to the stretch, dueled to mid stretch, took a short lead in deep stretch but could not stall the winner. JIMMENY CREEK came inward leaving the chute, bumped SMOKIN PADRE and knocked that one off stride, chased the pace to the turn, saved ground to the stretch and was making up ground belatedly. FREE RETURN was hustled to the front early, dueled from off the rail to the stretch, responded to mid stretch then was tiring in the late stages. EXPENSIVE PENS had no speed, got fanned four wide to the stretch and also was making up some ground late. BEERTALK had no speed, raced off the rail on the turn but failed to make an impact in the drive. GLOBAL OLYMPICS attended the pace three wide to the stretch then weakened. KNOWN ASSOCIATE tracked the pace early, saved ground on the turn but gave way in the stretch. SMOKIN PADRE was bumped by JIMMENY CREEK and knocked off stride once on the backstretch, briefly made a run to the turn but weakened thereafter. FOWLER ROAD chased the pace from off the rail to the stretch then tired.
