RABBITPEAK was not asked for speed in the early stages, commenced his bid while two wide on the turn then dropped to the rail once in the stretch, shifted outside leaving the furlong pole and finished steadily to gain command late and outraced VEGAS THIEF to win driving. VEGAS THIEF was never far back, angled four wide while setting out after the leaders at the quarter pole, closed steadily but could not match strides with the winner. CAZADERO had the best early speed, was engaged by OUR IRISH LORD nearing the half mile pole, took a clear lead on the turn and maintained the advantage into the stretch then weakened late. STILORGAN stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and weakened. GIFT N REGIFT lacked good early speed, was two wide on the turn but never reached contention. COBRAMATIC was forwardly placed from the outside, remained five wide on the turn and came up empty in the lane. OH GIANNI broke slow, saved ground and was never a factor. OUR IRISH LUCK broke a bit slow then rushed up from the inside to duel for the lead to the turn and stopped suddenly.
