CRAZY THINKING broke cleanly and tracked the pace from the outset, rallied three wide into the lane to gain command near the furlong pole and held driving. COOL HALEIGH raced unhurried early, was just off the rail on the turn and closed well through traffic in the lane. FAMOUS BOOTS prompted UPSTAIRS MAID two wide into the stretch but lacked a solid closing response. MY SIRAH SIRAH settled early, raced in the three path to the stretch, angled out a bit and was gaining late. UPSTAIRS MAID set the pace from the inside, gave way near the furlong pole then pulled up lame and was vanned off. PAPRIKA RED lagged early then saved ground to no avail. DIANA'S AVENUE was well placed early but lacked a closing kick from the inside.
