SKIP TONY set all the pace to the second turn, raced off the rail to the stretch then dug in determinedly to hold. C C'S DIAMOND pressed the winner throughout, was three wide to the stretch, got outkicked to mid stretch but kept to task to save second. INDIO CASINO was unhurried for a half mile, bid two wide to the stretch then could not muster the needed response. OLYMPIC FLAME chased SKIP TONY for five furlongs, was asked for speed three wide on the second turn but went evenly through the drive. WOLFGANG (IRE) had no speed, trailed to the stretch then had the rider drop his whip in upper stretch and did not rally. CAVA KAVIA stalked the pace three wide to the second turn, made a run four deep to the stretch to briefly loom a factor but weakened in the drive.
