Footnotes

MEAN JOLEENE took back at the break and raced unhurried from the inside to the second turn, responded once in the stretch to rally inside CEE THE LADY, took command in mid stretch and edged clear driving. DOUBLE RUSSIAN was permitted to settle early while two wide to the backstretch, commenced her bid once on the second turn, came three wide into the lane, challenged for command at the furlong pole but was outfinished by the winner. WALTZING SWAN lagged early, offered a menacing bid by trying to circle the leaders four wide on the second turn but flattened out in the drive. CEE THE LADY set the pace from the inside to the furlong pole and weakened. CHARS PROBLEM pressed the pace two wide for six furlongs and came up empty.
