Footnotes

STORMY SURGE never far away for a half mile, rallied three wide into the second turn, was going after the leader when that one broke down, inherited a good sized lead then was kept to task to the wire. SHEM chased the pace to the half, rallied three wide on the second turn then was no threat to the winner while second best. CAPTAIN ROY had no speed, was roused inside into the second turn, had to steady to avoid MEETINGWITHDESTINY nearing the quarter pole then finished steadily in the drive. MR. WOLVERINE was allowed to settle, got fanned four wide while offering his best bid on the second turn but flattened out in the stretch. EAGER PHARISIEN had no speed, was trying to rally between rivals on the second turn, got squeezed and had to steady then was forced to take up sharply and swerve out to avoid MEETINGWITHDESTINY and weakened through the lane. BOXELDER set the pace to the second turn, was overtaken then also had to steady when near the rail to avoid MEETINGWITHDESTINY, was eased in the stretch but walked off. MEETINGWITHDESTINY prompted the pace to the half, rallied to the front on the second turn but broke down shortly after taking the lead and was vanned off.
