Footnotes

SIR AL (IRE) took back just off the pace in the early going while racing just off the rail, moved a bit closer on the second turn, shifted three wide into the lane then responded nearing the furlong pole to gradually wear down the leaders late and won going away driving. MT. ORIENT was sent to the lead into the first turn then was taken in hand and set all of the pace under good rating, met a bid from EAST INDIAN in the upper stretch, disposed of that rival but could not hold the winner. EAST INDIAN pressed the pace two wide throughout, challenged at the furlong pole but slackened in the final furlong. TIME TO HONOR broke a step slow but raced up to stalk the pace three wide, was fanned four wide on the second turn and failed to rally. STARCAST saved ground to no avail. OUR MAN LUKE lagged early, saved ground throughout and never reached contention. TWO TURNS showed little. KALOOKAN STORM settled early while four wide to the backstretch, remained out on the second turn but did not respond. MOTEADO took back at the start and lagged then failed to respond while racing off the rail into the stretch.
