ONE MO broke alertly then was permitted to slip back off the pace, advanced four wide on the turn to loom a bold factor at the quarter pole but could make any serious impact until past mid stretch then took command and won driving. SUNDAY SEEKER also broke alertly but fell back quickly, circled rivals four wide to the stretch and closed steadily. SLYCY raced up inside under a snug hold to gain command early, set all of the pace to the stretch, resisted the winner until nearing the sixteenth pole then gave way. NATIONAL was void of early speed, saved ground and closed belatedly. PELITO lacked early speed, angled four wide on the turn and came on willingly. MAJ'R RULER saved ground to no avail. MORNING STORM stalked the pace two wide to the stretch and slackened. SECRET ELEMENT was well placed three wide for a half mile then did not respond. MR. DAY TRIPPER settled early, was two wide on the turn then lacked a rally. RIVERSMITH showed little.
