BLUE MOON HIGH broke alertly but took back just off the leaders while three wide to the backstretch, advanced two wide on the second turn, took command in the upper stretch, drew clear then gamely held off TEQUILA TONIGHT in the final strides. TEQUILA TONIGHT was permitted to settle early, raced inside BLUE MOON HIGH to the second turn, did not go with that rival to the stretch but responded leaving the furlong pole to close strongly to the final stages then hung in the final strides. ARRIVEDERCI CARO raced unhurried early from off the rail, came three wide to the stretch to loom a factor in the upper stretch but flattened out in the final furlong. BEAR MARKET pressed the pace two wide to the second turn, took command and dropped to the rail, dueled with the winner to the furlong pole then slackened. RISING ABOVE lagged early from the rail, raced in the two path on the second turn but failed to rally. BIG MAMA'S DRIVE'N set the pace from the inside to the second turn and stopped. AMBEDEUX stalked the pace from the inside for a half mile, dropped back suddenly and was eased in the stretch but walked off.
