MOUDEZ (IRE) took back at the start and lagged well back from off the rail, commenced his bid inside at the three eighths pole, swung out to be three wide into the stretch, rallied determinedly to reach the leaders late, bumped with NINER GENIUS while taking the lead and won driving. NINER GENIUS was always forwardly placed from the outside, remained three wide on the second turn, rallied to the deep stretch, brushed with the winner but could not match strides late. FARMER GILES (IRE) set all of the pace from the inside, took his longest lead at the furlong but was collared late. MICHAEL THE MAN stalked the pace from just off the rail into the stretch but lacked the needed response. KATIE'S DAN (NZ) was not asked for speed early, saved ground throughout and closed too late. BERT' N THE GROUP was well placed from off the rail for six furlongs and failed to respond. WAY TOO MUCH lugged out on the first turn, bumping with LETHARGIC and steadied, raced unhurried to the second turn and failed to rally while three wide. LETHARGIC broke a bit slow then was bumped on the first turn and showed little afterwards. THE TOUR DIRECTOR was never a factor.
