FUNNY HOW was taken in hand early and raced unhurried to the second turn, advanced from just off the rail into the stretch, angled to the extreme outside and unleashed an impressive rally to gain command near mid stretch and drew off as much the best. TWO BUCKS TO WIN stalked the leaders three wide to the stretch, forged to the front just past the furlong pole but proved no match for the winner. HOLLYWOOD FREDIE lagged early from the three path, came four wide into the stretch but could not threaten the top ones. TWO PARTS tracked the pace from the two and three paths to the stretch, took command at the furlong pole then came up empty. GENIUS LEVEL settled early, was two wide to the stretch and did not respond. TEDDY THE BEAR saved ground to no avail. JUST METEOR set the pace from the inside to the head of the lane and gave out. AGENTS BRUCE showed little.
