Footnotes

CONFUCIUS JUNIOR tracked the pace three wide to the half, was asked for speed while three wide on the second turn, shifted out for room in upper stretch then rallied determinedly, collared OLYMPIC FLAME and inched away. OLYMPIC FLAME prompted the leader to the second turn, rallied to the front two wide into the stretch, resisted the winner to deep stretch but was outfinished. VINDI MAN was four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace to the half, got fanned out four deep to the stretch then failed to offer the needed response. ANDYDAR stalked the pace for six furlongs then also lacked a rally when asked. PERFECT ENVOY set the pace for six furlongs, responded to pressure to the stretch but was tiring through the drive. GOLD STAR was forced out five deep on the first turn, settled to the half, saved ground to the stretch but was not a threat. HOT TUB AARON had no speed and was outrun. TURBULENT CREEK lost contact with the field after a half mile, was eased then walked off.
