Footnotes

SIMPERIO hesitated and broke a bit slow then lagged for the opening quarter, moved closer on the backstretch, bid three wide on the second turn, eased widest in the drive and closed steadily late. GAME EVENT stalked the leaders three wide to the second turn, remained three wide to the stretch, was up to duel to mid stretch then was outfinished by the winner while saving the place. GRAEME CRACKERJACK never far back to the second turn, raced up behind horses while two wide, was blocked and had to wait at the quarter pole, shifted out in upper stretch and responded to urging but was outfinished in the late stages. CALLDEROLL attended the pace while outside of ATIZ to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch, continued to respond to mid stretch but weakened in the latter stages. ATIZ was hustled and dueled for the lead inside of CALLDEROLL for six furlongs, responded to pressure to mid stretch then tired. FREE LOVIN' was four wide early, chased the pace to the second turn then gave out.
