### Footnotes

REINVENT was in front shortly after the break and controlled all of the pace from the inside, responded in the upper stretch and drew off while being kept to his task. DENNIS MAC settled early, rallied three wide into the stretch but flattened out. STRIKING OFFER lagged early, raced two wide on both turns and had no late rally. GLOBAL APPEAL stalked the winner two wide for six furlongs and weakened. EXTRA HOT was void of any early speed, saved ground to rally into the stretch then lost his punch. YARD DOG saved ground to no avail. BROADWAY ACT was well placed early three wide and stopped into the stretch. SOUVENIR CHEIF was only a brief factor.
