Footnotes

CLOCKER MOMENT was well positioned just off the speed early, rallied from the four path into the stretch to gain command near the furlong pole and drew clear driving. OLD MEMORIES lagged early, advanced from the three path into the stretch and finished willingly. BIRD COLONEL was fractious at the gate but broke alertly and prompted the pace from the inside into the stretch and slackened. THISLEGENDOFMINE settled early, rallied from the five path into the stretch then flattened out. JONNY T. lacked good early speed, rallied from just off the rail into the stretch, steadied sharply behind STORMY FRANK at the furlong pole, shifted out but lost his chance. WESTERN VINO set all of the pace from off the rail and weakened while drifting inward slightly. STORMY FRANK was well placed from off the rail, steadied inside WESTERN VINO at the furlong pole then again nearing the sixteenth pole and fell back. GIANT PANDA had no speed and was eased in the stretch. the rider aboard STORMY FRANK lodged an objection against WESTER VINO for interference in the stretch. The stewards ruled that STORMY FRANK always had room inside that rival and allowed the original finish to stand.
