MUSICAL ARTS raced up inside BONDIS SAVIOUR to gain command in the opening quarter, dueled to the stretch, drew clear and won driving. FLAMIN HOT MAMA settled early, advanced three wide on the turn to loom a bold factor once in the stretch but made no further impact. CAJUN MARKET broke a step slow and raced unhurried early, came off the rail nearing the quarter pole and finished steadily. REIGNING RUBIES was permitted to settle early, raced three wide to the stretch but did not respond. BONDIS SAVIOUR dueled two wide to mid turn and weakened. IRON FIREBALL was always outrun.
