**Footnotes**

STREET CAR raced up inside to stalk the pace in tight quarters on the rail, remained in tight on the turn and upper stretch but kept to his task to rally gamely in the final furlong and won driving. MERITRICIOUS raced unhurried early, steadied off heels nearing the quarter pole from just off the rail, lacked a clear path in the upper stretch, angled to the outside and offered a steady rally KILKENNY (NZ) stalked the pace two wide and between horses throughout, was in tight in the upper stretch, shifted out for room and finished steadily. RICHLIY RED broke in stride but was taken back off the lead, moved four wide on the turn to gain command nearing the furlong pole but could no sustain his bid. THE WHAMMER was never too far back, rallied between horses and three wide into the lane to offer his best bid near the furlong pole then flattened out. RULE HE MUST lagged to the turn, angled four wide to the strctch but lacked the needed response. CASUAL OBSESSION prompted the pace into the lane and gave out between horses. REAGAN REPUBLICAN was not asked for speed early, angled four wide on the turn but did not rally. HAYJAX sprinted clear early but was through once in the stretch.
