**Footnotes**

HOT CHACO took back at the start and raced unhurried from off the rail to the second turn, circled three wide on the second turn, continued to respond in the lane, forged to the front past mid stretch and held driving. OUR NAUTIQUE (NZ) was hustled from the gate to gain command out of the chute then settled, was well rated to the stretch, met the winner's bid at the furlong pole, dug in once headed but could not get back up. STALKING GOLD lagged early two wide, advanced three wide on the second turn and finished willingly. MCMURTRY pressed the pace from the three path early, continued to track two wide on the second turn but lacked a closing response. SEE ZO GO stalked the pace from the inside to the furlong pole and slackened. NINER GENIUS was well placed three wide to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch but had no rally. HIGHWAY BANDIT was void of early speed while easing to the rail, commenced his bid two wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response. CAHILL COUNTRY took back early then had no rally while two wide on the second turn. STRATE OFF THEBLOC saved ground throughout to no avail. RUNNINFORBACKPAY flashed brief speed to prompt the pace early then steadily faded.
