Footnotes

BALLET RIBBONS established a clear lead on the first turn from off the rail, gave up her advantage in the upper stretch but fought back gamely between rivals and was back up in the final stages. RIVER SLANEY chased the winner from off the rail, advanced to challenge from the three path into the lane, got to terms at the furlong pole but was outfinished in the late stages. VISION OF DANYMAC was permitted to settle early from the rail, remained inside on the second turn, rallied to gain command at the furlong pole but could not sustain that speed. STERLING MISTY raced unhurried early from the two path, moved out on the second turn to rally four wide into the stretch then flattened out. SLEEPING SIOUX settled early, tried to rally three wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response. CONTINENTAL CREAM was not asked for speed early from off the rail and trailed, saved ground on the second turn then did not rally.
