SPEED ROUSER settled in from the rail into the first turn within easy striking distance of the leaders, eased three wide to circle those rivals entering the lane, got to terms with SUMMER SUNSHINE in mid stretch and outdueled that rival. SUMMER SUNSHINE pressed the pace early from the rail, shifted two wide and continued to prompt to the head of the lane, took command in the upper stretch but could not quite hold the winner. STORMY SURGE settled early from just off the rail, tried to rally three wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response. RED COATS R COMIN gained command crossing onto the main course early and slipped to the rail into the backstretch, continued to lead to the head of the lane and slackened. DO WHAT U DARE was well placed two wide early but failed to rally. THE TOUR DIRECTOR lagged early, came through inside on the second turn but could not rally. CLASSICAL BARTOK stumbled at the start, quickly regained is footing and moved to the inside, saved ground thereafter to no avail.
