Footnotes

LADY HELM stalked the pace to the turn, rallied three wide and joined the leaders into the stretch, dueled to mid stretch then kicked clear in the final sixteenth. HOUSE OF CRYSTAL hesitated and broke slow, raced within striking distance to the turn, came three wide to the stretch, lacked room briefly behind FAH PEACHY in upper stretch but was clear nearing the furlong marker and was outfinished. SIERRA MADAM was hustled and dueled to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch, remained a factor to deep stretch then gave way. FAH PEACHY attended the pace from the rail to the stretch but tired in the final furlong. INDIGO QUEEN was outrun to the turn then had to circle four or five wide into the stretch and flattened out. COUNTRY TRAIL had brief speed but gave out on the turn. DOMESTIC MAID was not a factor.
