Footnotes

MAGIC OF THE MOON was not asked for speed early, commenced his bid once on the turn to rally inside into the stretch, eased outside PALI CHIEF past the furlong pole, was forced into STEPPINGINTOTHE LIGHT near the furlong pole and bumped with that rival but quickly recovered to gain command and won driving. RICK THE BARTENDER settled early, raced three wide on the turn, came to the outside for the drive and finished steadily despite being bumped by STEPPINGINTOTHELIGHT near the sixteenth pole. STEPPINGINTHELIGHT broke in stride and was taken in hand, became rank nearing the half mile pole and broke stride, settled, offered a menacing bid three wide into the lane, was bumped by the winner at the sixteenth pole and forced into RICK THE BARTENDER but kept gamely to his task. PALI CHIEF was sent up inside AMMUNITION in the opening stages to duel for the lead, edged clear in the upper stretch but drifted out at mid stretch, was corrected but faltered. AMMUNITION dueled two wide into the stretch and came up empty. The stewards posted the inquiry and reviewed the stretch run of the first four finishers but determined that it was the fourth place finisher, PALI CHIEF, at fault and allowed the original finish to stand.
