STATELY APPEAL tracked the pace from the inside throughout, moved up on the turn, challenged for command inside the furlong pole and gradually proved best. HEART'S MUSIC sprinted clear in the early stages and set all of the pace from off the rail, was engaged by the winner near the furlong pole, then was outdueled gamely. TOMMY'S PICK raced unhurried early from the inside, angled three wide entering the lane and rallied steadily but could not get up. PEEK A BOOP stalked the pace from the outset, entered the lane three wide but lacked a closing response. MUSIC TEACHER was never too far back, had her best bid four wide nearing the quarter pole but lost her punch in the lane. LUCKY SPELL lagged early then saved ground to no avail. BALLET RIBBONS was never a serious factor.
