Footnotes

DO WHAT U DARE was hard used from the gate to gain position in heavy traffic, raced off the rail on the turn continued to respond in the drive and was up driving. TRUCKIN was sent hard for the lead from off the rail, dropped inside on the turn and raced gamely to the line but could not hold. CAZADERO prompted the pace two wide, forged to the front near the furlong pole but slackened in the drive. IRISH ROVER settled early, advanced four wide to the stretch and flattened out. CHELE was under a snug hold in traffic and three wide to the stretch then lacked the needed response. I C SPUTNIK raced unhurried early, was blocked for much of the turn, eased out for a clear path at the head of the lane but remained blocked until past the furlong pole while working his way inside then could not rally. WATCH YOUR MONEY was permitted to lag early, was fanned five wide on the turn and went evenly through the stretch. GIFTED STUDENT stalked the pace three wide to the stretch and weakened. AMERICA'S KID was hard used from the rail to race up to contention, was in tight nearing the turn and got shuffled back.
