MAMOONYA pressed the leader to the second turn, rallied when asked at the three eighths, was carried three wide into the stretch but pushed to the front to mid stretch then held on stubbornly. ZEPHANIAH stalked the pace to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, could not catch the winner but collared GLOBAL STARTER late for the place. GLOBAL STARTER set a pressured pace for a half mile, was put to a drive nearing the three eighths, could not hold off the winner into the stretch then was caught by the runnerup in the late stages. RAISING MEMO was allowed to settle to the second turn, advanced two wide to the stretch then angled out sharply for room in mid stretch but could not close any ground late. WALKER RD. was also settled for a half mile, saved ground to the stretch but failed to mount the needed response. PISA PLAYBOY had no speed, trailed to the second turn, was three wide to the stretch and lacked a late bid. ROMAN RAHY tracked the pace from the rail to the second turn but gave out after six furlongs.
