ACAFFELLA took back early and raced under patient handling to the second turn, commenced his bid inside KINGSFORD DRIVE at the three eighths pole, circled the leaders three wide into the lane, took command once straightened for the drive and then drew off under only very brief urging. MOMENT OF WEAKNESS (IRE) stalked the pace outside of LUCKARUCK from the outset, had his best bid into the lane but proved no match for the winner. KING COLA raced unhurried early from the rail, came two wide on the second turn, angled out for the drive and finished steadily without being a serious factor. BLUEGRASS REWARD was void of early speed from off the rail, saved ground on the second turn and passed tiring horses. LUCKARACK stalked the pace from the inside to the stretch then failed to respond. EL GAUCHO was hustled to the lead in the early stages then set the pace without pressure in hand but had little resistance when challenged into the stretch. KINGSFORD DRIVE was well placed four wide early but stopped three wide on the second turn and was eased in the stretch but walked off.
