RULE HE MUST was permitted to settle just off the leaders from the inside, angled three wide at the quarter pole to be challenging for command once in the stretch, took command nearing the furlong pole and drew clear driving. AMERICAN WILDCAT alternated on the lead outside STEPPINGINTHELIGHT into the stretch, disposed of that rival but could not stall the winner. STEPPINGINTHELIGHT dueled for the lead from the inside to the head of the lane and slackened. GHOST REIGN settled early, raced two wide on the turn but failed to rally. MR. CANDY BAR was void of early speed, saved ground to the stretch and came on without being a factor. KARABAKH stalked the pace four wide to the stretch and came up empty. MARCOMAN lacked good early speed then saved ground to no avail.
