Footnotes

CITY TO CITY contested the pace inside rivals to the turn, was off the rail and responded to inch clear to mid stretch then was kept to task to the line. SALTY FRIES broke out and bumped TORNADO BETTY at the start, stalked the leaders to the turn, shifted out four wide and rallied into the stretch, loomed a threat to mid stretch but could not sustain the needed bid. CHANDLERS HEART was among the leaders in the opening quarter then was outsprinted to the turn, made a bid inside but was in traffic and forced to check briefly leaving the five sixteenths, shifted out into the stretch and was gaining late. SWEET TOPPER had no speed, raced four wide to the stretch and was making up ground belatedly. TORNADO BETTY had no speed, was in the two path while edging closer to mid turn then also got caught in traffic, had to check and wait to the quarter pole, angled in nearing the three sixteenths but finished evenly late. MISSY DIXIE was hustled and dueled for the lead three wide to the stretch then gave out. QUIET RIVER had speed to the turn, dropped back to the stretch and stopped in the drive.
