Footnotes

ROCKFORD settled mid pack for a half mile, bid three wide on the second turn, pushed to the front in mid stretch and held on driving. ARGYLE CUT saved ground while tracking the leaders, remained inside on the second turn, was boxed in and lacked room, tried to force through leaving the quarter pole, bumped with UPTOWN BIG BROWN into the stretch then had to angle out for room but closed willingly once clear. THREE STRIKE RULE attended the pace outside of UPTOWN BIG BROWN, remained a threat on the second turn then was outkicked to mid stretch and finished evenly. FLAGMAN had no speed, trailed to the second turn, circled four wide to the stretch but could not make an impact in the drive. CONVINCED HIMSELF also had no speed, settled to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch but flattened out in the late stages. UPTOWN BIG BROWN had good speed, dueled for the lead from the rail for six furlongs, was bumped by the runnerup into the stretch and gave way through the drive. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run involving ARGYLE CUT and UPTOWN BIG BROWN but though there was contact between the two, it did not cost UPTOWN BIG BROWN a placing so no change was made.
