Footnotes

WILD DATE was unhurried for a half, rallied nearing the second turn, was three deep then fanned four wide into the stretch, continued to respond and wore down THE DOLL ROOM late. THE DOLL ROOM The latter settled to the half, bid three wide on the second turn, pushed to the front in upper stretch, resisted the winner to deep stretch but could not hold. UR MY DIXIE GIRL settled mid pack to the second turn, saved ground while advancing on the second turn but was outfinished through the final furlong. DOVER CROSSING lagged to the half, closed the gap and was three wide on the second turn but could not threaten late. MISS CALIFORNIA was unhurried and raced towards the rear to the middle of the backstretch, was inside rivals but was shuffled back nearing the three eighths then came two wide to the stretch but went evenly late. REDSEASALT was pushed out four deep on the first turn, dropped inside of LEWKODONIA on the backstretch, moved to the front and led to the stretch but tired in the final furlong and had the rider drop his whip in the late stages. THATS VISTA'S GIRL chased the leaders to the half, edged closer to the second turn, was three wide to the stretch then gave way. LEWKODONIA was hustled early but drifted out into the first turn, gave way after a half mile then stopped through the stretch.
