KID STUFF was outsprinted to the turn, commenced a bid three wide leaving the three eighths, was four wide to the stretch, continued to respond through the final furlong and won driving. WINTER WARLOCK chased the leader to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch, was up to duel for the lead to mid stretch, could not stall the winner in the late stages but saved second. INDIAN WINTER also was chasing to the turn, came two wide to the stretch then closed ground belatedly. FORMAT V. had no speed, raced three wide to the stretch and finished in a rally. CABO CHICO was sent hard and pushed clear in the early stages, had a good lead but drifted out slightly into the stretch, got collared a furlong out and tired. TUSHER MTN MAN was used early but was outsprinted, chased the leader two wide to the stretch then gave way. KISSN TRISTAN trailed throughout.
