OLYMPIC FLAME was well placed to the second turn, rallied three then four wide to the stretch and continued to respond in the final sixteenth to be up in time. C C'S DIAMOND moved up into the backstretch to duel for the lead from between horses, was outkicked by TWO BUCKS TO WIN into the stretch but kept to task in the final furlong then was bested in the late stages. A DAY AWAY never far back from the rail to the second turn, remained inside to the stretch, rallied to take a short lead leaving the sixteenth marker but could not hold. TWO BUCKS TO WIN set the pace to the backstretch, dueled inside a three horse spread to the second turn, responded to edge away into the stretch but was tiring through the final furlong. SLIM PICKINS was allowed to settle for a half mile, raced four wide on the second turn then had to circle rivals six wide into the stretch but responded when set down for the drive and was closing ground late. INDIO CASINO broke slow and trailed to the second turn, was not making progress in the drive when he became a bit erratic and bumped with DRAW TWO BUCK late. ANDYDAR was three wide in the early stages then pushed up to attend the pace on the backstretch, raced three wide to the stretch but tired in the final eighth. DRAW TWO BUCK had no speed, settled to the second turn, lacked a response in the drive then was bumped by INDIO CASINO leaving mid stretch. SUNDAY COMIC was fractious in the gate, broke slow then settled while four wide to the backstretch, tried to rally but was forced out five wide on the second turn and gave way in the drive.
