CHERRY ON THE CAKE contested the pace two wide to the stretch, responded and edged away to mid stretch and was under steady urging to the line. FLAMIN HOT MAMA attended the pace outside the winner, was three wide to the stretch, got outkicked to mid stretch but saved the place. MISTISIZED chased the leaders to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch then could not muster the needed late response. MISSDANG SALLY was a pace factor in the opening quarter mile, got outkicked by the top two on the turn, eased out in the stretch but also did not rally. LITTLEMISSGOGO got outsprinted early, was fanned four wide on the turn and did not threaten. OLD WAY had no speed, came three wide to the stretch then eased widest but came up empty. CAJUN MARKET had no speed, was not a factor then bled in the stretch and was pulled up.
