**Footnotes**

FUNTRIP took back early and settled on the rail, advanced two wide on the second turn, rallied quickly into the stretch, avoided the fallen horse near the furlong pole and continued her bid then was up in the final strides. EXCLUSIVE DEPOSIT was permitted to settle early, moved to serious contention from off the rail on the backstretch, challenged from between horses into the lane, led near the furlong pole and was tagged late. CARLA ANGEL prompted the pace three wide early, challenged in the upper stretch but weakened in the lane. DYNAMIC LACEY lagged early, commenced her bid from the inside on the second turn, steadied approaching the fallen horse near the furlong pole, then came on late. FASTEST STAR settled early, raced three wide on both turns and failed to rally. THE EMSTER took back in the early stages, tried to rally four wide on the second turn and failed to respond. MEMO BAY was a bit rank from the rail into the first turn, stalked the pace to the second turn then stopped and was eased but walked off. FIRST ALLIED set all of the pace from the inside to the furlong pole, attempted to hurdle the rail nearing the furlong pole and fell. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the fallen horse but allowed the original finish to stand.
