Footnotes

DRAMATIC was always within striking distance while racing unhurried, circled rivals four wide on the second turn, challenged for command nearing the furlong pole, dueled with EVENING FIRE to the late stages then gradually proved best. EVENING FIRE tracked the leaders from the outset, offered her bid three wide on the second turn, led at the furlong pole but could not resist the winner in the final stages. RADIANT HEAT stalked the pace from the rail to the stretch, shifted out at the furlong pole but finished evenly. AWARD WINNING trailed to the second turn, rallied from off the rail into the stretch and closed with some speed. TEA DANCING lagged early, raced four wide on the second turn and finished in a mild rally without being a serious factor. MULTIPLE (IRE) took command in the early stages and crossed over near the rail, set all of the pace into the stretch then gave way inside at the furlong pole. FANTASTIC CAREER was permitted to settle from the rail, raced two wide on the second turn and came on late. SENDIPITY stalked the pace three wide early but gave way two wide on the second turn.
