JOSHUA'S DREAM broke alertly and tracked the pace between horses early, moved up two wide on the second turn, took command in the upper stretch inside the leaders and drew clear driving. CHANGING (ARG) lagged early three wide, offered a menacing bid three wide on the second turn but lost his punch in the lane. SKYSPY close up early, advanced three wide on the second turn to loom a factor and gave way. ONE SHOT (ARG) set the pace from off the rail to the head of the lane and gave out. PLEASANT PROSPECT raced close up from off the rail but had little response from the inside on the second turn. SANFRAN lagged early, raced two wide throughout and failed to rally.
