MAN FROM LAGOS raced up in the opening quarter inside PARTY AT MYU PLACE to duel for the lead, gained command near the quarter pole from off the rail, edged clear at the furlong pole and held driving. HEIR TO MONEY lacked good early speed, raced two wide on the turn and finished steadily. KOFINHO was permitted to settle outside HEIR TO MONEY, angled to the four path nearing the stretch but flattened out in the lane. PARTY AT MY PLACE dueled outside the winner into the stretch and weakened. SKATTLE SEATTLE was off a step slow but reached contention early from the inside, saved ground to the stretch but lacked the needed response. FIVE A DAY stalked the leaders from the inside to the stretch and came up empty. CHUMASH JOE was never a factor.
