LUNCH TIME was void of early speed despite hustling tactics from the gate, lagged to the turn, came four wide to the stretch, rallied determinedly and was up late to win driving. STRAWBERRY LAKE (ARG) stalked the pace two wide early, shifted three wide into the lane, rallied to the lead late but could not stall the winner. PORTLAND STORM tracked the dueling leaders three wide, took command nearing the furlong pole but weakened past mid stretch. CRAYON RED set the pace from off the rail into the lane and slackened. SEAFIRE lacked early speed, raced three wide on the turn and failed to rally. JUNIOR BROWN raced close up early but faded from the inside after the opening quarter. JAMAICANMELATE dueled from the inside to the turn and came up empty.
