Footnotes

NEW CENTURION took command early and set all of the pace without pressure, drew well clear in the upper and extended his advantage driving. PELITO was void of early speed while racing well off the rail, circled rivals four wide on the second turn and closed willingly but too late. DON'T STOP RIDIN' was forwardly placed from off the rail, advanced four wide on the second turn but lost his punch in the lane. CURLY BOY stalked the pace from the inside to the upper stretch and weakened. NATIONAL saved ground to no avail. NONSENSE was never a serious factor. I. C. BLUE showed little. SIBERIAN RUSH saved ground throughout but had no response. GOOD DEFENSE was well placed to the second turn and gave out. STROLL FOR US raced as a factor from the outside to the second turn and then had nothing left.
