BARBAROSSO broke alertly and chased VOTE from the three path throughout, responded in the lane to take a short lead at the furlong pole but was all out to hold in a hard drive. VOTE set all of the pace from off the rail, responded once headed and gave way grudgingly. MALLINSON ROAD (NZ) settled early from off the rail, commenced his bid four wide on the second turn but could make no impact. IDLE CHATTER raced unhurried early, was two wide on both turns and was gaining slightly at the end. SPEED ROUSER stalked the pace from the rail into the stretch then failed to muster a closing response. OUR MAN LUKE saved ground to no avail. ONE ROYAL STAR was always outrun.
