Footnotes

BETTINGONTHETRUTH broke in stride and raced close up three wide from the outset, was patiently handled to the second turn, moved up two wide to challenge into the stretch, took command at the furlong pole and edged clear driving. TENSE JUSTICE was permitted to settle early from off the rail, came three wide on the second turn and finished steadily. SHOWING PULPIT lagged early to the backstretch, offered a menacing bid four wide on the second turn but flattened out once in the stretch. SETTINTHEHOQ took command into the first turn and crossed to the rail, was headed on the backstretch but remained a factor from the inside to the head of the lane then slackened. PERFECT KIVA raced unhurried early then saved ground to no avail. GOLDEN MIST was not asked for speed early then lacked a closing response while racing two wide into the stretch. BROTHER JOHN pressed the pace early, took command once on the backstretch, maintained an advantage to the upper stretch then kept to his task when headed until the deep stretch when he lunged and tried to hurdle the inside rail near the finish and unseated his rider.
