**Footnotes**

MIKE'S TRIPPIN broke alertly and dueled outside GULP to the stretch, edged clear once straightened for the drive and held driving. INAHURRY was void of early speed, angled four wide on the turn and finished full of run. COUNTRY RHYTHM lacked good early speed, raced just off the rail on the turn and closed through traffic. EVRYBODYCUTFOOTLOS settled early, rallied into the stretch but flattened out late. BEN'S STARRY NIGHT close up early, raced two wide on the turn but failed to rally. MOONLITE ROMANCE lacked good early speed but finished willingly too late. WARREN'S SECRET stalked the pace three wide but had no response in the drive. APPEALING DREAM was never a factor. CODE AMOUR showed little. ELEGANT ICE flashed speed from the outside then failed to respond while four wide on the turn. GULP dueled from the rail to the stretch and stopped.
