

Footnotes

TAKIN A BREAK took a favorable striking position into the first turn from the outside, commenced his bid three wide on the second turn, challenged RUMMYSECRET WAR from the outside at the quarter pole, dueled to the line and just prevailed. RUMMYSECRET WAR set a pressured pace from the rail, disposed of BREAKING RANKS once on the second turn but was quickly engaged by TAKIN A BREAK, battled that rival to the deep stretch and gave way grudgingly. SHADOW JUSTICE settled early, saved ground into the stretch and rallied. MISTER STANKY was close up from the inside into the stretch, shifted out and finished willingly. SEATTLE DELEGATE lagged early, was fanned four wide on the second turn and came on steadily. JOSHUA'S DREAM was permitted to settled early from off the rail but failed to respond into the stretch. BREAKING RANKS dueled two wide to the second turn and gave out. MIX showed little.
