IMBLENDEDNOTSHAKEN broke cleanly and was forwardly placed without need of rushing, advanced three wide into the stretch, rallied steadily in the drive and was up late. NOWUCHIMNOWUDON'T was well placed just off the pacemaker, rallied to that rival two wide to take command in the upper stretch then was caught in the late stages. IVANHO settled early from the rail, remained inside to the stretch and closed a gap in the lane. POINT HAPPY lacked good early speed, raced four wide on the turn and came on without being a serious factor. LA MIDNITE SPECIAL lacked early speed, rallied from off the rail into the stretch then flattened out in traffic. MAGIC SPIRIT was slow in the early going, advanced inside to the stretch but lacked a clear path behind a tiring OL STEELY BLUE leaving the furlong pole and raced in check for several strides until able to get around that rival. GATITOCCEE settled early, raced four wide on the turn and failed to rally. NEWS BEAT was fractious at the gate and showed little. OL' STEELY BLUE sprinted clear early and crossed to the rail, led to the head of the lane then stopped.
