DANCING YODELER took a favorable striking position from the inside in the early stages, had to wait for room behind the leaders nearing the stretch, shifted out once in the stretch, rallied willingly to gain command past the furlong pole and won driving. PUMP N UP lacked good early speed, circled rivals five wide to the stretch and finished steadily. JIM'S GOLD PICK was off a bit slow but quickly reached contention from the outside, rallied to the lead three wide in the upper stretch but slackened leaving the furlong pole. STEELY WONDER was well placed to turn turn, came four wide to the stretch and gave out. SKY TERRY settled early, raced in the two path on the turn but did not respond. ALMOST FOOLISH had no speed. ROYAL STORMER set the pace from the inside to the stretch and stopped. BERT'S PAL dueled two wide to the stretch and had nothing left. YERPULLINMAHLEG was eased through the stretch but walked off.
