MIDNITE IN KONA chased the pace to the turn, rallied four wide and took a short lead in upper stretch, inched clear to mid stretch then held on stubbornly. TORNADO BETTY stalked the leaders early then fell back a bit to the turn, swung out four wide for room, rallied when called upon in upper stretch and closed steadily but was too late. YES NO WHATEVER tracked in the early going, shifted out three wide mid turn then could not make an impact in the drive. APPEALING RESUME pressed the pace to the turn, bid three wide and took a short lead leaving the five sixteenths, dueled into the stretch but weakened through the final furlong. QUIET RIVER was hustled to the front, set the pace to the turn, was collared leaving the five sixteenths, drifted out in the stretch and stopped.
