Footnotes

SKELLYTOWN was always within striking distance while racing outside horses and unhurried to the second turn, moved up three wide into the lane, took command near the furlong pole and drew clear driving. GREY ALYCATTa was void of early speed, circled rivals three wide on the second turn and finished steadily. SUNDANCE KIDDO set the early pace from off the rail, disposed of SUDDEN EXCESS on the second turn to gain a clear advantage but gradually weakened in the lane. GULF WING was not asked for speed early, saved ground throughout but lacked the needed response. SUDDEN EXCESS pressed the pace from the outside for six furlongs and weakened. GLOBAL STARTER settled early from the inside, came off the rail on the second turn but failed to rally. ELEGANT VICTOR raced outside GULF WING most of the way but never responded. CHIEF LITTLE MAN was rank into the first turn while close up, remained a factor to the second turn then came up empty.
