RIVER SLANEY took a clear lead on the first turn from off the rail, was well rated throughout, drew clear in the upper stretch and held driving. WHOS CALLING NOW settled early from the rail, raced in the two path on the second turn and was closing late. KATIEINTHEFASTLANE chased the winner from the three path throughout but had no late response. LUCKY SPELL lagged early from off the rail, came four wide to the stretch but had no rally. VISION OF DANYMAC was permitted to settle early, raced three wide throughout and came up empty. SCREAMIN EXPRESS was unhurried early from off the rail then failed to respond while three wide into the stretch. DON'T SMOKE was well placed early but came up empty from the inside on the second turn.
