KILMORA dueled from the rail to the stretch, responded to pressure in the late stages and inched clear. GRANT MARTY ADREAM was a pace factor outside the winner to the stretch, battled to deep stretch then was outfinished and just saved the place. TALKTALKTALK chased the top two to the turn, came three wide to the stretch then rallied to deep stretch and surged late to just miss second. SWIM SUIT MODEL was inside of TALKTALKTALK while also chasing the leaders, responded when set down for the drive then was also surging in the late stages. LEMON BERRY hesitated and broke slow, raced well back while saving ground to the stretch then closed a gap late. FOOL ME TWICE also hesitated and hopped out of the gate, trailed to the stretch then also closed the gap without being a threat.
